

Dear Friends,

Many of you are familiar with the crisis due to the war in northern Uganda. Many of you have seen the film *Invisible Children* or slept outside in boxes at "Displace Me" a few years ago, or followed the signing of the LRA bill by President Obama last May, or even travelled there yourselves. For those of you to whom this does not sound familiar, I would encourage you to visit the links below or see the film and educate yourselves on Africa's longest running war.

I have for many years followed the events surrounding northern Uganda and the LRA, and this summer I've been given the opportunity to personally visit and serve in Gulu, Uganda. I'm excited to be able to participate in restoration and relief and to meet the people we've shared solidarity with from so far away.

For about two weeks (June 30-July 15) I'll be joining a team from my church, **ROCKHARBOR**, to serve in Uganda. We'll be working to encourage and aid the people there through partnering with Gulu Community Bible Community Church, a church planted by ROCKHARBOR and Africa Renewal Ministries. We'll help run children's ministries, give medical aid by assisting with things like basic wound care, participate with the church in local evangelism efforts and community outreach, and serve in other ways asked of us by the church. Most importantly we'll be loving and supporting a community that's in need.

So many of you have been so faithful in supporting me through my various mission trips and involvements over the years and I'm very thankful. Once again I would ask you to remember me in prayer for this trip, and if you are able, to participate with me by giving financially towards the costs associated with travel to Uganda.
